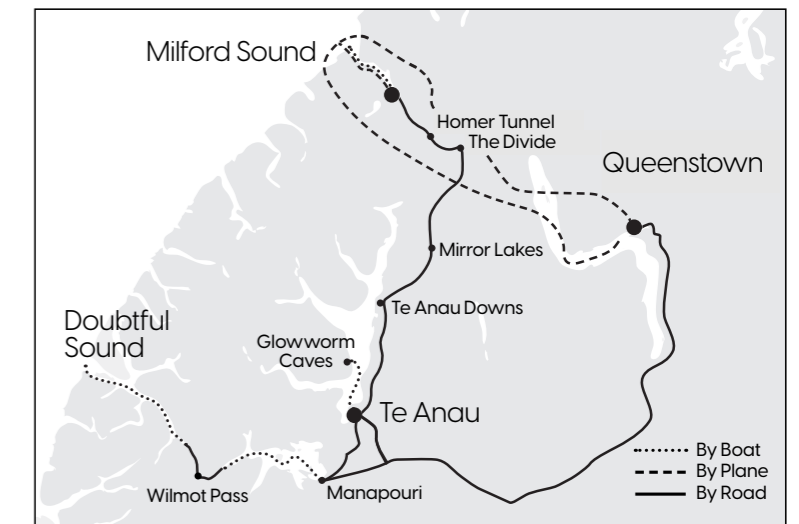


# New Zealand's best kept secret ...
